Partners from 6 countries gathered around the table to brainstorm ideas to deliver this innovative project and achieve best results possible.

One of the outcomes of this project will be a set of audio interviews with experts, such as teachers, facilitators, adult educators and trainers. In total, partners will create 20 audio files covering the in-demand skills featured in the World Economic Forum report.

First, we will prepare guidelines on the interview technique. This will ensure that a consistent and methodical approach is taken in delivering this part of the project.

Each partner will focus on two skills from the list and will create content in their national language which will subsequently be translated into English.

The next step will be to create video interviews with HR managers and entrepreneurs who have successfully implemented the skills in question. This content will demonstrate how the upskilling process might look in practice.

Last but not least, we will focus on delivering 18-hour face to face training. This will be a cornerstone of further sustainability of the project as we will teach 14 trainers from all across Europe how to use the tools created in the project. Ultimately the trainers will be able to use the newly learned coaching methodologies to enhance knowledge and qualifications of adult students.
