What is the Top 10 Skills project?

Top 10 Skills, also known as New Skills for a New Labour Context, is designed to prepare people for a changing workplace in 2020 and beyond.

Seven project partners are working together to create training resources to improve employability through developing new skills, such as emotional intelligence and empathy.

What stage is it at?

The project team met in Córdoba, Spain, in October to review and agree next steps.

Within phase 1 (Top 10 trainers) twenty training modules have been completed and are ready for testing. The training modules include information, techniques and exercises in skills such as creative thinking, negotiation and cognitive flexibility.

What next in Phase 1?

These training modules will now be tested by staff trainers working with volunteers. Their views and feedback will be used to produce the final versions, which will then be freely available online.

The World Economic Forum has listed the following ten skills as essential for the workplace of the future:

Complex problem solving, critical thinking, creativity, people management, coordinating with others, emotional intelligence, judgement and decision making, service orientation, negotiation, cognitive flexibility

Winter workshops

Each partner is planning half-day workshops with professionals in human resources and training, before the end of January 2019. The workshops will introduce the project's new concepts, ideas and training materials and in particular emotional intelligence – its use and advantages - in the workplace.

Phase 2 - Workers for a new Era

For the second phase of the project the partners are creating some interactive training activities and exercises for workers. This training will help workers to improve their knowledge of the top 10 skills and prepare them for the future.

This training material will be developed in early 2019 and will be tested in the same way phase 1 is being tested.
