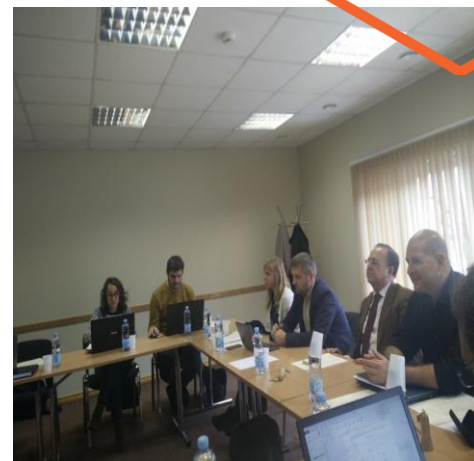

### Second Meeting in Sigulda, Latvia

#### World Economic Forum Report Conclusions:
